Figures of Expression explores the multifaceted nature of expression through figurative art and portraiture. The works engage with themes of identity, belonging, and the complexities of the human experience. Each artist brings a unique storytelling approach, transforming traditional notions of representation into intriguing narratives that illuminate diverse human connections.


Asad Ali Qulander harnesses the transformative quality of light to evoke nostalgia and deepen our understanding of perception, prompting reflections on the ephemeral nature of memories. Ayesha Tanveer captures the interplay of past and present, weaving collective memories into her work and inviting explorations of shared human experiences. Fatema Shahid addresses the realities of overcrowded living conditions, reflecting on familial dynamics and survival, adding poignant social commentary to the dialogue on identity and belonging. Fatima Faisal Qureshi investigates the relationship between identity and the body, challenging perceptions of comfort and discomfort, thus enriching the exhibition's exploration of selfhood. Qasim Joyo's portraits intend to intimately capture the essence of a person, in hopes that they may see a truthful reflection of themselves. Salar Marri emphasizes the materiality of paint to evoke vitality and introspection in the human form, inviting contemplation of existence.

Together, these artists illuminate the diverse narratives embedded within the human figure, creating a tapestry of reflections that encourage viewers to engage with their own connections to identity and memory.



Asad Ali Qulander

Asad Ali Qulander, a visual artist & 3D generalist from Lahore, specializes in oil painting, 3D modelling, and concept art. He graduated from the National College of Arts (NCA) in Lahore in 2024. He has exhibited nationally and internationally, including "Peace And Prosperity Through Art" in Azerbaijan (2023) and "The Past Is A Country" at Rajiv Menon Contemporary in Los Angeles (2024). In Pakistan, his work has been showcased in Art Next "Yahan Se Agay," "Recent II" at Tagheer, Kaleido Kontemporary "Neo Wave," Khamsa Art. Qulander recently held his first Solo in Islamabad (2024).






At the Edge of Light, 2024











Qasim Joyo


Salar Marri


Fatema Shahid
